SUBJECT: Anderson Dog Park & Shared-Use Trail

Dane County Parks will start construction of the dog park and shared -use trail at Anderson Farm County Park beginning in July. This project is identified in the Anderson Farm County Park Master Plan, adopted in 2013, and was a recommendation in the 2018-2023 Dane County Parks and Open Space Plan.

The dog park will be located at the southern end of the park, where 35 acres of cropland was planted to prairie earlier this year in February. The dog park will include a small dog area, two paved parking lots, a stormwater basin, perimeter fencing and gravel trail system. The shared-use trail will be a 10-foot wide asphalt trail that parallels Union Road connecting the dog park with the Arthur Sholts Memorial Woods and the adjacent neighborhood to the north via the existing South Main Street access.

Construction will begin at the dog park parking lots in July and work on the trail will follow later this year. The dog park and trail are anticipated to open in summer of 2021.
