### Payment Options

**Option 1:** Drop off in secure drop-box- located in the Town Hall parking lot.

**Note:** Want a receipt? Put your email in the memo line of your check and we will send you an electronic receipt or enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope for a paper receipt.

**Option 2:** Mail your payment to Town Hall – 1138 Union Road, Oregon, WI 53575.

## Snow Removal Guidelines

The Town of Oregon road crew strives to plow and remove snow from the roads as efficiently and safely as possible.

Please follow the DO's and DON'Ts below to help the snow removal crew clear your street efficiently.

- DO park your vehicle(s) in your driveway, off the street, especially in cul-de-sacs.
- DO OBEY all snow emergency rules/regulations, parking signage, and parking regulations.
- DO NOT push or blow snow into or across streets or pedestrian areas
- DO NOT put trash and recycling carts in the street. Place in your driveway.

### **Town Tax Dollars Support the Oregon Area Senior Center**

**Take advantage of the many free, donation-based or reduced-cost options available there!**

**Adult Day Program** - State-licensed program that provides safe, supportive, social setting and offers a respite opportunity to caregivers

**Meals** - Weekday lunches served at the Senior Center or at Ziggy's on Thursdays, home-delivered meals for those who qualify, meals can accommodate special diets and are available to those 60 and over on a donation basis. Twice monthly parking lot pick-up of Little John's meals **regardless of age**

**Case Management** - Case Managers provide help for seniors on a variety of issues including housing, financial issues, home chore, home health, Medicare, and Part D Planfinders

**Loan Closet** - Medical equipment for short term loan **regardless of user age**

**Transportation** - Options include rides to medical appointments, grocery store, food pantry, lunch at the Senior Center or Ziggy's on Thursday

**Exercise and Wellness** - Variety of exercise classes taught by physical therapists or certified instructors (**no age limits on classes**), weekly blood pressure screening, weight loss support group, health and wellness education, free medication checkups with pharmacists

**Recreation** - Large number of entertainment and social programs, craft groups, volunteer opportunities, **no age limits**.
