

**ORDINANCE NO. 93**

**AN ORDINANCE TO LOWER THE SPEED LIMIT ON GLENWAY ROAD**

The Town Board of the Town of Oregon, Dane County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. Sections 8.10.010 c. and d. of the Town of Oregon Municipal Code are hereby renumbered as d. and e., respectively.

2. Section 8.10.010 c. of the Town of Oregon Municipal Code is hereby created to read as follows:

“c. The speed limit on Glenway Road in the Town of Oregon between its intersection with Lincoln Road westerly to its intersection with Alpine Road shall be forty-five (45) miles per hour.”


3. This ordinance is adopted following Dane County speed studies that showed that, at certain times, the existing speed limit of 55 miles an hour has been greatly exceeded by users of the Town highway, to the detriment of the public safety for citizens of the town of Oregon. Accordingly, the Town Board has concluded that the existing 55 mile per hour speed limit for Glenway Road between these locations is greater than is reasonable and prudent for users of such Town Highway.

The above and foregoing Ordinance was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Oregon on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2022.





Accordingly, the Town Board has concluded that the existing 55 miles per hour speed limit for Glenway Road between these locations is greater than is reasonable and prudent for users of such town highway, and that the speed limit above and foregoing Ordinance was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Oregon, Dane County, Wisconsin, on January, 2022.


